WHEREAS, The Council's work over the years established a standard for authentic and reliable research; now therefore be it

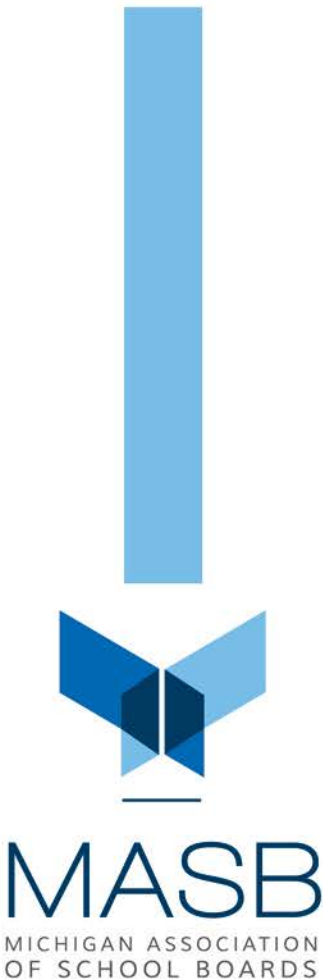
